Pick something **INTERESTING** & **COMPREHENSIBLE**—
a book you can **ENJOY** & can **MOSTLY UNDERSTAND**.

- 1. Easier to read is usually better.**
- 2. Interest trumps everything—if you like it, read it.**
- 3. Don't look up every word that you do not immediately understand. If you don't know a word, *skip it*—look it up later if you need to.**
- 4. If you don't like it or don't get it, pick a different book.**
