HOW TO PICK & READ A NOVEL

Pick something *INTERESTING* & *COMPREHENSIBLE* a book you can *ENJOY* & can *MOSTLY UNDERSTAND*.

- **1**. Easier to read is usually better.
- **2.** Interest trumps everything—if you like it, read it.
- **3**. Don't look up every word that you do not immediately understand. If you don't know a word, *skip it*—look it up later if you need to.
- **4.** If you don't like it or don't get it, pick a different book.
