Almost all of these books are interchangeable across levels. Lower-level students can understand if you explain and convert the text into more simplified speech and ask lots of questions. You just tell the story at their level rather than reading it word-for-word. Higher-level students can also benefit from a story they understand and are interested in—they always can pick up more grammatical subtleties and idioms from the rich language found in children's books.
