Find something <u>INTERESTING</u> and <u>COMPREHENSIBLE</u> for you to read. Keep trying different materials until you find something that works for you. You are looking for...

<u>something that you like</u> & <u>can understand</u>; material that <u>keeps your attention</u> & that <u>you can read without struggle</u>.

PICK SOMETHING THAT IS:

ENGAGING & **UNDERSTANDABLE** to you **ENJOYABLE** & **RELATIVELY EASY** for you **PALATABLE** & **ACCESSIBLE** to you

- It does not have to be utterly fascinating, and you do not have to understand every single word.
- It should just <u>hold your interest</u> for a while, and it should be something that you can <u>mostly understand</u>.
- If you don't like it, or it doesn't make sense to you, choose something else to read next time.
- Reading the same book again may be a good option too.
